विषय - हिन्दी



6. माता—पिता या बड़े बुजुर्गों के सम्मान हुते कविता लिखें जो दूसरों को भी प्रोत्साहित करे।




Subject: Mathematics

PROJECT WORK

Prepare a project/working model on types of angles.

Subject : Science

- **REVISION** Draw a flow chart showing the properties of acids and bases, different types of indicators, their examples, and colour changes in acidic and basic medium. (On a chart)
- WORKING MODEL Design a working model to demonstrate the role of the diaphragm in breathing, showing how it contracts and relaxes to facilitate inhalation and exhalation.

You will need a plastic bottle, a Y shaped glass or plastic tube, thin rubber sheet, thread, two balloons and a cork with a single hole.



• **PROJECT WORK** –Prepare a project file that describes the steps involved in wastewater treatment.

Use maps, diagrams, and drawings wherever necessary.

Section A: Locality - Then and Now

- 1. **Project Work:** Enquire from your parents and prepare a comparative chart or scrapbook page showing how your locality has changed in the past 20 years. Include:
 - Infrastructure (roads, buildings)
 - Population
 - Cleanliness and sanitation
 - Shops and markets
 - Any major development projects
- 2. **Interview Task:** Talk to any senior citizen (grandparents/neighbour) and ask them the following:
 - What changes have they noticed in your locality?
 - What do they miss about the old locality?
 - What improvements do they appreciate today? Write a summary in 150 words.

Section B: Local Administration - Nagar Palika

- 1. **Roleplay Script Writing:** Write a short play/script (1-2 pages) showing how Nagar Palika helps in solving a local problem (e.g., garbage collection, road repair, or water supply). Characters: Councillor, Nagar Palika Officer, Local Resident, etc.
- 2. **Flowchart Activity:** Draw a flowchart explaining how a complaint (e.g., garbage issue) reaches the Nagar Palika and how it is resolved.

Section C: Indian Sub-continent - Climate & Monsoon

- 1. **Weather Diary:** Maintain a 5-day weather diary of your city/town:
 - Temperature (Min & Max)
 - Rainfall (if any)
 - Cloud Cover/Wind
 - General Observation (sunny, rainy, humid, etc.)
- 2. **Map Activity:** On an outline map of India:
 - Mark and label 4 major regions receiving heavy rainfall.
 - Shade the Western Rajasthan region with light colour showing arid climate.
 - Write the average annual rainfall of any 3 regions.
- 3. **Short Note:** Write a short note (100–120 words) on the importance of the monsoon for Indian agriculture.

Bonus Activity (Optional):

 Create a collage using newspaper clippings or pictures related to climate change or rainfall-related news in India.
