
- (क) पर्यावरण से संबंधित कोई चित्र बनाएँ तथा स्वयं रचित कविता लिखें।

Keeping Safe

Objective:

To help students understand basic safety rules and how to protect themselves in different situations at home, school, or outside.

1. Safety Drawing Activity

Task: Draw a picture showing how you keep yourself safe in one of these places:

- At home
- On the road
- At school
- In the park

Use crayons or colour pencils. Write 3-4 sentences about what you drew.

2. Learn and Write – Safety Rules

Task: Write any 5 safety rules you follow in daily life. Choose from these topics:

- Road safety (e.g., crossing the road)
- Fire safety
- Water safety (e.g., swimming pool, bathroom)
- Online safety (using phones/tablets)

Write in your own words.

3. Role-Play with Family

Task: Act out a short safety scene with your parents or siblings. Make a video of 2 minutes only and share it with your subject teacher.

Examples:

- What to do if there's a fire at home
- How to call for help in an emergency (dialing 100 or 112)
- Saying "NO" to strangers

Write a few lines about what you learned from this activity.

4. Create a “Safety Tips Poster”

Task: Make a poster with the title: “My Top 5 Safety Tips”

- Use drawings and write short tips.
- Decorate with colors or stickers.
