1. Open Microsoft Excel.

4. In Column C, enter how much you spend each day.
5. In Column D, use a formula to calculate "Money Left" for each day.

Formula: =B2-C2

6. At the bottom, use SUM function to find:

Total Money Received

Total Money Spent

Total Money Left
